SURFACE MINING COMMON CORE TRAINING

**Mandatory for all who work on a site*

This program is intended to train anyone working on a Surface Mining Site. The Occupational Health and Safety Act and Surface Miners Training Standard states that anyone working on a Surface Mining Site must have Surface Mining Common Core Requirements Training.

Duration: 1 Day (6-8 hours)

Overview:

Recognizing and avoiding hazards specific to a Surface Mining Environment. Safe practices such as:

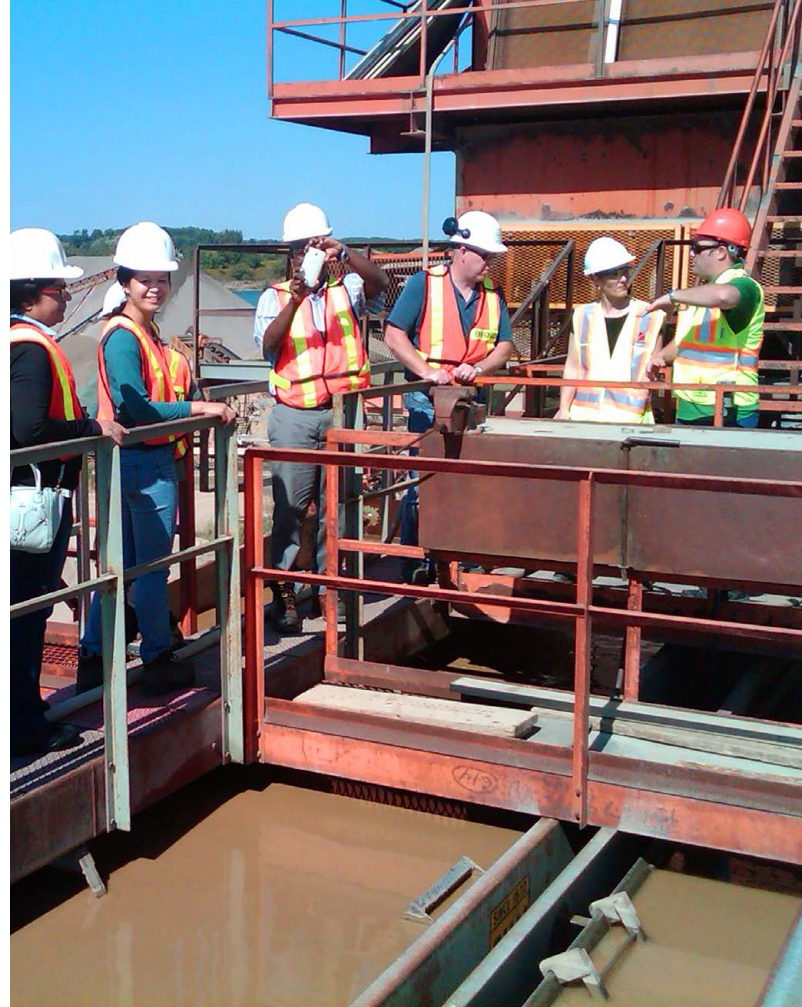

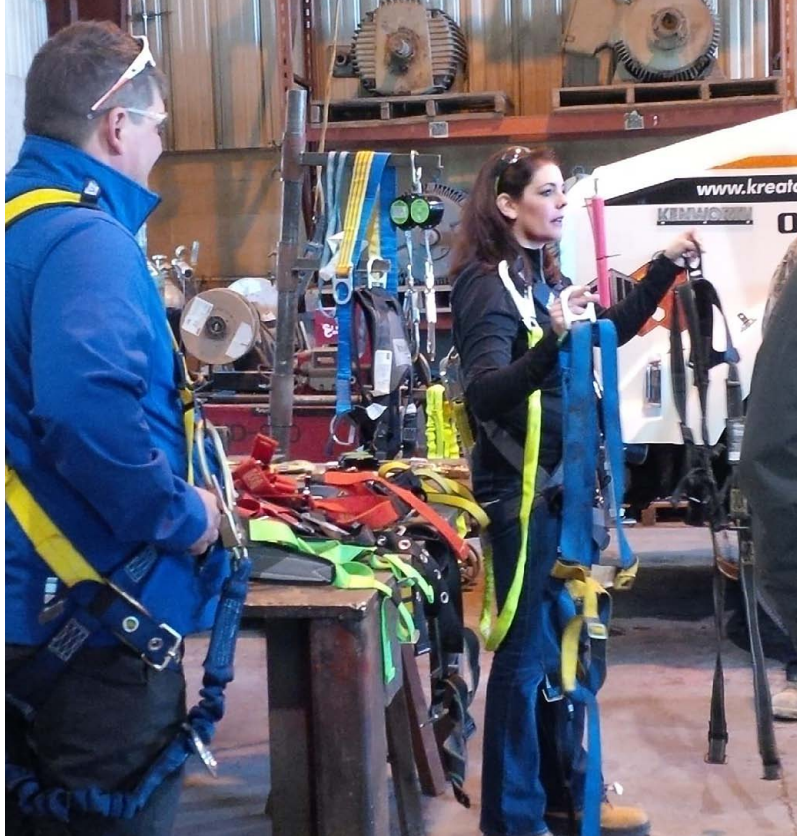

OSSGA TECHNICAL TOUR TO SOUTH CAROLINA

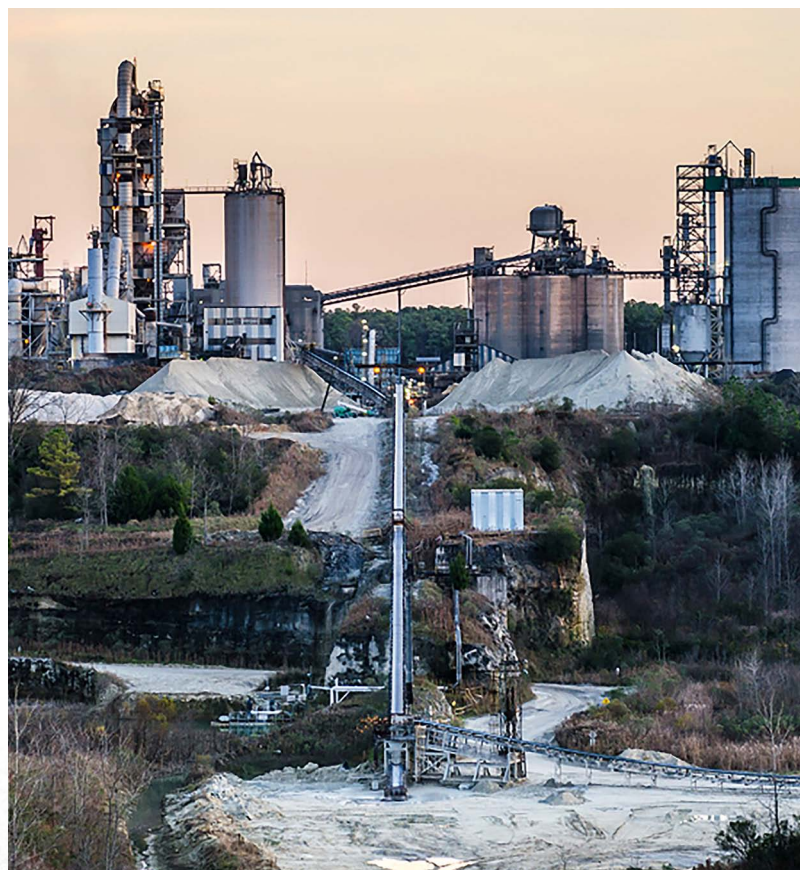
