

OSSGA PROTOCOLS FOR IN-PERSON GATHERINGS

As we start in-person gatherings again, we are implementing a number of protocols to ensure the safety of attendees, our staff and vendors.

Here are important changes we have added to meetings, events and training:

PROOF OF COVID IMMUNIZATION

Digital and/or physical COVID immunization proof will be mandatory at check-in for all OSSGA in-person gatherings. We will not store your information, only check to ensure you have been fully immunized at least two weeks prior.

HEALTH SCREENING

All attendees will be required to complete a health screening form. You may be asked to withdraw your participation from the meeting as a result of your screening answers.



SANITIZER STATIONS

Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the venue, including at entry and registration. Attendees will be asked to sanitize before entering the event.

MASKS REQUIRED



To limit any potential health risks, staff and attendees are required to wear a mask at all times except when eating, or outdoors, or where you can social distance at least 6 feet apart. If you forgot your mask, OSSGA will provide one for free at registration.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Signage will remind attendees to practice social distancing during registration and the meeting. *Please note, there may be instances when social distancing is not possible. Ensure you are wearing your mask in these instances.*



TABLES AND BUSES

Each round table seats approximately 10 people. Seating will now be limited to 5 guests. Classroom tables that normally seat 2 will now be limited to 1 person. Each row on a bus usually seats 2 guests, rows will now seat 1 guest.

LIMITING PHYSICAL CONTACT



We understand there may be close friends you see at our events, and if mutual physical embrace like handshakes or hugs happen, that's okay as long as other individuals are comfortable and provide consent.

GATHERING WAIVERS

Our team is working closely with our venues and vendors to ensure our in-person OSSGA meetings, events and training are following all government and insurance provider regulations and recommendations. With that said, we need to ensure you and your guests understand and acknowledge the potential health risk of any in-person event. By agreeing to our waiver you acknowledge you understand the potential risk of attending in-person OSSGA events and will assume any responsibility if you were to contract COVID-19.
