AGGREGATE TRUST APPOINTS NEW PRESIDENT

Bruce Semkowski has been appointed the new president of [The Ontario Aggregate Resources Corporation](#) (TOARC).

Bruce is well known in the aggregate industry as a long-time employee of Lafarge, most recently as vice-president and general manager of the company's Eastern Canada operations. Prior to his employment at Lafarge, Bruce worked for King Packaged Materials Company. He is also a past chair of the [Ontario Stone, Sand & Gravel Association](#) and past board member of TOARC.

Bruce takes the reins at TOARC from founding member David Sterrett, who retires after 15 years of loyal service as TOARC president.
